Objectives

1. To capacitate the most vulnerable households in understanding their disaster.
2. To support municipality in mainstreaming and scaling up household level preparedness into annual development.

Target households

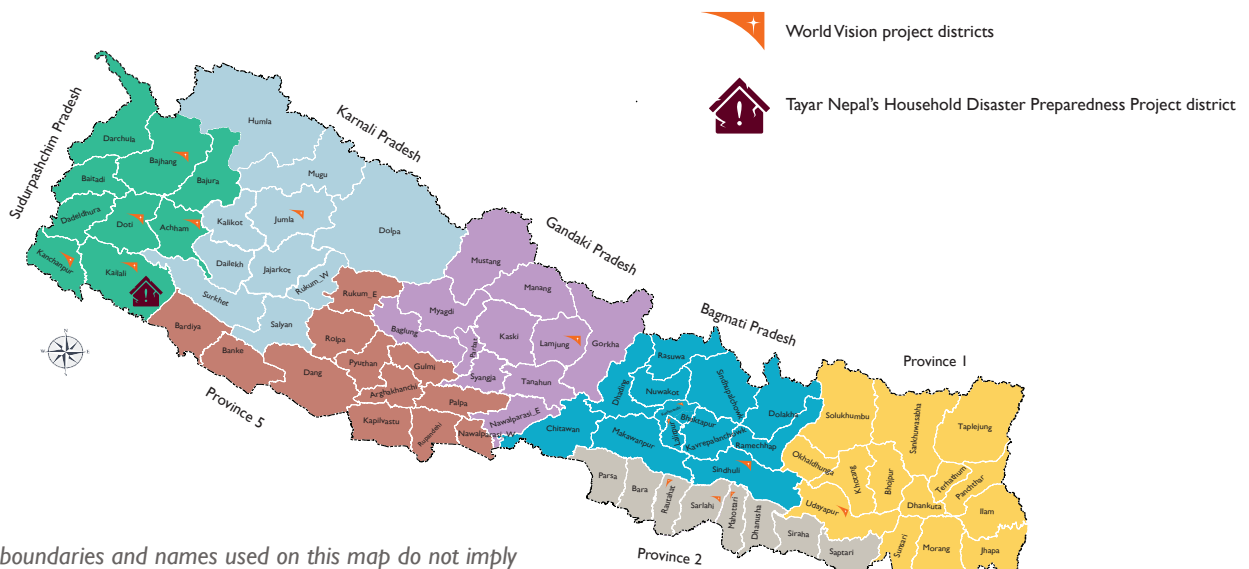


Direct : 550 HHs

Indirect : 1647 HHs

Key progresses

- Completed project inception meetings in the working areas;
- Completed designing and development of mobile-based Participatory Disaster Risk Assessment (PDRA) tool, currently on operational phase;
- Developed PDRA android application for the household-level PDRA surveys;
- Completed household-level PDRA survey in 1,741 HHs of ward 9 (working areas) of Lamkichuwa Municipality;
- Identified 588 most vulnerable households and developed individual Household Disaster Preparedness and Response Plans (HDPRPs);
- Supported formulation and operationalization of nine Community Disaster Management Committees (CDMCs) and Ward Disaster Management Committees (WDMCs); and
- 86 CDMC task force members trained on first aid, early warning, and search and rescue.
